Dear Parent/Guardian:

Connecticut state law and the Wethersfield Board of Education require that each tenth grade student have documentation of a completed health assessment (a "physical"). In order to satisfy this requirement, your child must have a physical completed between September 1, 2015 and June 1, 2017 and you must submit a fully-completed Health Assessment Record (form HAR-3) to the WHS school nurse prior to the beginning of your child's junior year. This form can be found on our website at: www.wethersfield.k12.ct.us. Select "Our Schools" and then "Wethersfield High School" and then in the left column select "Health Office." The Connecticut State Health Assessment form can be downloaded from that page. You can also pick up the form in the WHS main office.

Please note that sports forms DO NOT FULFILL THIS REQUIREMENT. Only **the fully-completed Health Assessment Record** (Form HAR-3) will satisfy this requirement.

Failure to submit the fully-completed Health Assessment Record (Form HAR-3) to the high school prior to the start of your child's junior year may result in your child not being able to begin school for the 2017-2018 School Year.

Please feel free to contact us if you have any questions about this requirement. We are notifying you in advance so that you may schedule a complete physical exam/immunizations for your child with your medical provider within the prescribed time period.
